Bill Smith, Village Administrator:

- * Improvements and repairs to sidewalks have been started
- * Will be patching roads and filling potholes beginning 7 March
- * The village is trying to contact AEP about improving lighting on 3rd Street
- * Contractor began working on Well 5 on 6 March
- * State Rt 669 will be repaved either this year or next.
- * “Final Inspection for new maintenance building was conducted on 3 March, did not pass. Cannot have dead bolts on the man doors with separate handles, need to have additional bracing on the trusses.
- * A new street employee has been hired and is doing a great job.
- * Rett is working out well at the water plant.

Council Member, Homer Weekley:

* Discussed issues with the Malta Village Web Site – we need IT to be more responsive to updates to the site.

* Asked a question for a village resident regarding a new fence and would he need a building permit. The answer is yes.

* Discussed “Hometown Heros” banner program and would like to have banners in place by Memorial Day. Several details need to be worked out for this to happen. Price and application will be available for review at our next meeting

* River fest is coming here this summer, during the first week in July.

Council Member, Leslie Robbins

*As decided during a Finance Committee meeting, recommend making Fiscal Officer Ashley Stevens a full time position. Motion made by Homer Weekley and seconded by Scott Moore to make the change. Roll call vote, all yeas.

* Asked if there was any resolution to the issue presented by Mr. John Woods at the last meeting. Bill reported that the street crew had be working on the problem and had dug additional holes and used cameras to find any broken or collapsed pipes and were not able to locate anything. Problem may exist in the homeowners basement. Continuing to try to isolate the problem

Council Member, Devan Vincent:


* Next meeting about America250 will be on April 8
