- * Talked about upgrades to the administration building and removal of a large tree in the front that is encroaching on the monuments and flag poles.
- * Discussed the most recent sewage bill, the finance committee will meet and discuss.

Presented emergency Ordinance 26-08 **AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AMENDING AND REVISING THE APPROPRIATIONS OF EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF MALTA FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2026 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

A motion to suspend the rules for Ordinance 26-08 **AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AMENDING AND REVISING THE APPROPRIATIONS OF EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF MALTA FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2026 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY** was made by Leslie Robbins, seconded by Jamie White. Roll call vote, all yeas.

A motion to adopt Ordinance 26-08 **AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AMENDING AND REVISING THE APPROPRIATIONS OF EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF MALTA FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2026 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY** was made by Jamie White, seconded by Leslie Robbins. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Bill Smith, Village Administrator:

- * Replacing two meters in the water treatment plant. Meters are \$11,000 per meter, plus installation costs.

Council Member, Jamie White:

- * Asked about plans for sewage line between Schaad's and the ministry building, Bill reported it is on the schedule for May 22, 2026.

Council Member, Scott Moore:

- * Lands & Buildings Report is complete and will be available at the next meeting
- * Asked about "speed bumps", Bill said installation is scheduled for May 22, 2026
- * Still trying to collect information to help with convincing the county to repair or replace the Veteran's Bridge

Council Member, John Woods:

- * Asked Scott if letters will be sent to addresses in his report, the answer was yes, they will be
- * Mentioned areas around the village that belong to the village that also need to be cleaned up and organized

Council Member, Don Larrick:

- * Memorial Day Parade will form at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, May 25, 2026 in front of the Malta Administration building
- * Units will step off at 10:00 a.m., proceed across the Veteran's Bridge and up Main Street to The Commons and circle around back to The Court House for the program.
- * After the program, The American Legion Auxiliary will provide lunch to the parade participants at the VFW in Malta
