- * A banner got destroyed, will need to be fixed. Looking into replacement costs as well as new costs.
- * Riverfest & Jeep Fest will be July 11, 2026. Jeep ride begins at 8:00 A.M. There will be 5 bridges, but only 3 can be driven across. The ride is about 2 and a half hours. Riverfest is Noon-4:00 P.M. Food will be available and a beer garden.
- * ODNR will bring a pontoon boat and give rides up and down the river thru the locks. There is no rain date incase of rain.
- * The park has been well kept and clean.
- * There may be money available to fix the Veteran's Bridge.
- * Roundabout signs are coming together – going to start working on them this week.
