REGULAR SESSION

Held: July 21, 2026

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The Village of Malta Council convened in REGULAR session at 6:10 p.m. in the Malta Village Council Chambers. Visitor Bruce Dearing told council his driveway is concrete but is now covered in stone due to the water run off from the hill behind his home.

The Habitat For Humanity driveway is washed out, Mayor McGrath and Village Administrator Bill Smith say they will contact Habitat For Humanity and see if they can fix it.

* Spent 1 year working on grants.gov website and finally have it all straight and are able to use the site.

Bill Smith, Village Administrator:

* Town has been flooded.

* Boys have been working on Echo Street since it flooded.

* Joint Utility Meeting went well.

* Meeting with R-CAP on July 22, 2026.

* People are still inquiring about building tiny houses in town. The current ordinance states homes must be 1,200 square feet. Considering adding amendment to accommodate tiny houses. Mayor McGrath suggests councilmen Jamie White, Scott Moore and Homer Weekley get together to discuss the matter.

Council Member, Homer Weekley:

* Riverfest was rained out. Jeepfest still did the ride.

* Zanesville would like Riverfest to come back to Zanesville, Rotary suggested rotating between Zanesville and Malta.

* Would like council to get together and plan an event called Summerfest.

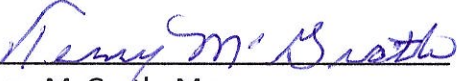
Council Member, John Woods:

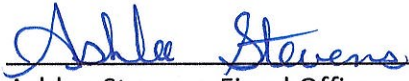
