- * There is money out there, seems likely we could get the funding.

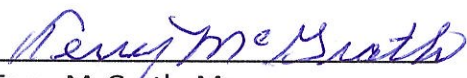
Council President, Leslie Robbins:

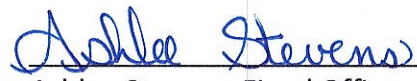
- * Asked to be excused from June 16 and July 7 meetings.
